


#### Neb. ESP Comparable Occupation's Hourly Wage vs. Living Wage








## Living Wage of Lincoln Region vs. ESP Comparable Occupational Hourly Wage




## Living Wage of Omaha/Council Bluffs Region vs. ESP Comparable Occupational Hourly Wage




## Living Wage of Sioux City IA/NE Region vs. ESP Comparable Occupational Hourly Wage




## Living Wage of Western Nebraska Region vs. ESP Comparable Occupational Hourly Wage




## Living Wage of Central Nebraska Region vs. ESP Comparable Occupational Hourly Wage



## Living Wage of Northeastern Nebraska Region vs. ESP Comparable Occupational Hourly Wage




#### Living Wage of Southeastern Nebraska Region vs. ESP Comparable Occupational Hourly Wage

## ESP Comparable Occupational Hourly Wages by State vs. State Living Wages




