NSEA-Retired ballots were counted on Tuesday March 19, 2024. According to NSEA-Retired Bylaws Article 5, Section 3, the NSEA-Retired President shall be first delegate to NSEA Delegate Assembly and NEA Representative Assembly. The attached election results are for the additional elected positions to those two assemblies as well as for general officers of the Association.

A total of 1280 ballots, an approximate return of 23%, were received prior to counting the ballots.
