Introduction of Proposed Resolutions

New Resolution # 1 moved by Jim Bunch:

Be it resolved that SEAN supports efforts that advocate the continuing professionalism of Para educators, including the support for adequate salaries and continuing education. As the population of exceptional learners continues to increase in school classrooms it is important to support the need for trained professionals to assist classroom teachers. Any attempts to decrease salaries, benefits, and tuition assistance, or otherwise negatively impact the ability of Para professionals to be adequately compensated should be resisted.

  - E.5. Computer Literacy: SEAN recognizes the increasing effect of computers in our lives and supports computer literacy in school curriculum. (83,88)
- Melissa Sorenson seconds.
- Vote passes unanimously.
- Rae Carbaugh pulls Article F Section 7 and would like to add questioning following the word "transgender".
- o Rae moves to amend current resolution to add wording of questioning:
  - F.7. SEAN supports a safe place for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and ally students and teacher to learn and teach.

- Vote passes unanimously.
