⁴ The NEA Fund THE NATIONAL EDUCATION ASSOCIATION FUND FOR CHILDREN AND PUBLIC EDUCATION (NEA FUND)

The NEA Fund for Children and Public Education collects voluntary contributions from Association members and uses those contributions for political purposes, including, but not limited to, making contributions to and expenditures on behalf of friends of public education who are candidates for federal office. Only U.S. citizens or lawful permanent residents may contribute to the NEA Fund. Contributions to the NEA Fund are voluntary; making a contribution is neither a condition of employment nor membership in the Association, and members have the right to refuse to contribute without suffering any reprisal. Although The NEA Fund requests an annual contribution of \$15, this is only a suggestion. A member may contribute more or less than the suggested amount, or may contribute nothing at all, without it affecting his or her membership status, rights, or benefits in NEA or any of its affiliates.

Contributions or gifts to the NEA Fund are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation and name of the employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. Federal law prohibits The NEA Fund from receiving donations from persons other than members of NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families. All donations from persons other than members of NEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families, will be returned forthwith.

² Dues NSEA POLITICAL ACTION FUNDS AND REFUNDS

NSEA is actively involved in financial support for recommended candidates for state and local office. NSEA's political action program is supported by voluntary contributions collected with the membership dues. This year's contribution is \$15.00 for full-time active members and \$7.50 for half-time and active substitute members. Individuals in other membership classifications make no PAC contributions. Any NSEA member may request a refund of their contribution for the current membership year. Refunds are made after January 1 of each year, upon written request from an individual member. A refund notice will appear in the NSEA Voice. Membership is open only to those who agree to subscribe to the goals and objectives of the Association and to abide by its constitution and bylaws.
