


### Q1 Which of the following best describes your job?

### Q2 Which of the following grade levels do you work with the most?





# Q3 How many total years, including this one, have you been an employee in any school or school system?





## Q4 Are you working more than/less than/about the same as you did last year?





## Q5 How many additional hours of work each week have been added to your typical workload?





## Q6 How would you rate your personal stress level compared to last school year?





### Q8 Have you had to cover classes for colleagues?





## Q10 Have you personally experienced an increase in mental health concerns?




