The NSEA Bylaws and Policy Committee continues to refine and update the NSEA Board Policy Book and the NSEA Bylaws. The NSEA Bylaws and Policy Book can be found on the nsea.org website.

The committee dealt with two major bylaw changes, one coming from EMAC and the other from the Governance Review Taskforce.

Bylaw Amendment No. 1 would create a voting position for an EMAC at-large representative to the NSEA Board of Directors. Bylaw Amendment No. 2 would implement a variety of changes to the structure of NSEA governance. Should Bylaw Amendment No. 2 be passed at Delegate Assembly, Bylaw Amendment No. 1 would be moot, since No. 2 includes a voting EMAC position on the NSEA Board.

The Committee recommended a position of support for both Bylaw Amendment No. 1 and No. 2 being presented to the NSEA Board.
