

Report of the Awards Review Committee

The committee looked at adding one award that is given out at the Delegate Assembly, the Administrator of Excellence Award. It was determined to make the language consistent with the other awards given. The nomination process will remain the same for all nine of the awards and will be available for the 2021 nominations.

The Administrator of Excellence Award honors an administrator that strives every day to get students and staff to be successful. The climate the administrator or administrative team sets in a building by their leadership, actions and support of students and staff can determine the success or failure of that environment. The definition of an administrator is someone in the position of superintendent, assistant superintendent, principal or assistant principal. Nominations for this award are based on advocating for public education, willingness to seek out input from educators and support of the NSEA. To nominate and administrator, submit the nomination form and an essay of no more than 500 words explaining the nominee's qualifications. **The local association president must sign the nomination form.**
