Report of the Bylaws and Policy Committee

The NSEA Bylaws and Policy Committee reviews Bylaws of the Association as well as policies in the Association's policy manual. The Committee proposes changes to the Board of Directors for adoption by the Delegate Assembly by a two-thirds vote of delegates. Amendments are proposed in writing a minimum of 45 days prior to the Assembly and referred to the Bylaws Committee. Review and submission for the 2024 Delegate Assembly consist of committee recommendations. No additional Bylaws were submitted for Delegate Assembly consideration; no additional policies were submitted for the Board of Directors consideration.
