1. Grants will not exceed \$100 per project.
2. Individual members or associations may apply.
3. Grants will fund ONLY projects or activities that promote or enhance education.
4. The Tri-Valley Board will select grant winners based upon the first received that meet the criteria shown above and for which money is available.
5. The project must be completed within this association year.
6. Grant application must be completed and returned by the last Tri-Valley District Board meeting.
7. At the completion of the event/activity, send itemized receipts for the amount requested. No alcohol may be included.
