




Q2 Which of these best describes your job?







Q5 Which of the following best describes how students are receiving instruction this semester?





Q6 Do you believe your current learning model is equitably meeting the needs of all of your students?





Q7 Based on the current prevalence of COVID in your community and public health guidelines, do you think all staff should be mandated to wear masks?










Q15 Are you working more/less/about the same as you did last year?





Q16 How many additional hours of work each week has been added to your typical workload due to COVID changes this year?





Q17 How has the COVID pandemic affected your long-term professional planning?





Q18 Taking everything into consideration, how likely is it you will make a genuine effort to find a new job with another employer within the next year?




